"A Policy of Exclusion: Canada's approach to asylum seekers"

Andrew Brouwer is a staff lawyer at the Refugee Law Office, a staff office of Legal Aid Ontario (LAO), and is currently on secondment to LAO's Policy and Strategic Research Department. Before joining LAO, Andrew was in private practice for 7 years at Jackman and Associates, a leading refugee law firm in Toronto. Prior to entering law, Andrew worked in social justice and refugee policy at The Maytree Foundation and Citizens for Public Justice. Andrew holds leadership and advisory roles with a number of NGOs including the Canadian Association of Refugee Lawyers (CARL), the Canadian Council for Refugees (CCR) and the Canadian Centre for Victims of Torture (CCVT), and has represented CARL and CCR in a variety of test cases before the Supreme Court of Canada as well as the Federal Court and the Federal Court of Appeal. His articles on refugee law and policy have been published widely, including by the Globe and Mail, Toronto Star, National Post, Embassy Magazine, Caledon Institute of Social Policy, and UNHCR, and he is frequently invited to speak by community and legal groups and by Parliamentary committees studying refugee legislation.
