Dr. Martin Geiger (PhD University of Bonn, 2010) is Associate Professor of 'Politics of Human Migration and Mobility' at Carleton University, Ottawa. His work focuses on international organizations and non-state actors, and the transformation of global, regional and national migration politics. Dr. Geiger is the author, co-author and co-editor of more than 40 academic articles, chapters, books and reports published e.g. in the *Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies* or the 'International Political Economy series' of Palgrave Macmillan, including *The Politics of International Migration Management* (2010/2012), *Disciplining the Transnational Mobility of People* (2013) and *The International Organization for Migration. The New 'UN Migration Agency' in Critical Perspective* (2020/forthcoming).
